Note:

What you need

- Sponges
- Paint
- Paper
- Scissors

Instructions

Either keep the shapes of the sponges as they are or cut shapes out of them. Dip them in paint, or watercolours, and print onto paper.

Top Tip:

- Add a peg to the sponge so little ones can grab and stamp easier
- Tie an elastic band around the middle of
